Although the menu varies, you are sure to find an all you can eat, family style spread of wonderful chicken, ham and/or beef served with mashed potatoes, homemade bread and their famous peanut butter spread. End the farmhouse meal with homemade pie.

Der Dutchman Restaurant:

At Der Dutchman Restaurant, you will experience the unique Amish and Mennonite culture, which is well known for traditional home-style cooking & hospitality. Enjoy the all-you-can-eat breakfast buffet with Amish Country favorites like fried mush, biscuits & gravy, scrambled eggs, bacon, sausage, potatoes, pancakes, french toast, grits, fruit slush, yogurt, fresh fruit, and fresh pastries.

Rock and Roll Hall of Fame:

The mission is clear: to engage, teach and inspire through the power of rock and roll. The Rock and Roll Hall of Fame shares stories of the people, events and songs that shape our world through exhibits, innovative programs and concerts.

Great Lakes Science Center:

The Great Lakes Science Center is a museum and educational facility right next door to the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. Many of the exhibits document the features of the natural environment in the Great Lakes region of the United States. The facility includes various exhibits such as NASA Glenn Visitor Center, Bridge of Fire, Elliptical Pool Table, Augmented Reality Sandbox, and an IMAX Dome theater. Admission includes us one show at the Domed Theater & access to the Steamship William G. Mather.

Wednesday August 9th

Nationwide Arena (Home of the Blue Jackets!)

Located on the corner of Nationwide Boulevard and Front Street in downtown Columbus, Nationwide Arena was built on a piece of property that was the site of the historic Ohio State Penitentiary. The support of naming rights partner Nationwide Insurance paved the way for the city to acquire an NHL expansion team. Named one of the best arenas in the NHL, the facility opened to great fanfare in September of 2000 and has since hosted the NHL All-Star Game, regular season and playoff hockey, NCAA championships, local, regional and national conferences and a multitude of concerts and touring events.

High Bank Distillery

Enjoy a tour and tasting at High Bank Distillery. The name comes from the fact that Columbus, Ohio was founded February 14th, 1812 on the HIGH BANK of the Scioto & Olentangy river fork. High Bank Distillery is the home of the best blended whiskey in America as Awarded by the 2021 & 2022 San Francisco World Spirits Competition but also make vodka and gin.

Anthony-Thomas Chocolates

Anthony-Thomas' success spans 5 generations with an accumulation of over 185 years of experience between the family and is the largest family-owned-and-operated candy company in the Midwest.
