CONVENTION INFO

CHILDREN AT CONVENTION

Children are welcome at convention, and those 16 and under stay for free in the room with their parents, and they must use the beds that are in their room. The fee (\$175.00) includes both dinners, breakfasts, and welcome bag. Children are allowed in the banquet rooms for meals and to hear any presentations, but when the dancing begins at dinner, they must leave. It is the responsibility of the parents for the conduct of their children at all times. If they become a distraction, they will be asked to leave whatever room they are in by a committee member. No one under the age of 21 shall be allowed into any hospitality room while alcohol is served

TUESDAY – August 6th

The Grand Ole Opry (Evening show TBD)

Join us for a night at the Opry, the Grand Ole Opry. The official lineup will be available closer to the date, but sure it will be an entertaining show.

The Grand Ole Opry is an American weekly live country music radio broadcast from the Opry House in Nashville, Tennessee. It was founded on November 28, 1925, by George D. Hay as a one-hour radio "barn dance" on WSM. Currently owned and operated by Opry Entertainment, it is the longest-running radio broadcast in U.S. history. Dedicated to honoring country music and its history, the Opry showcases a mix of famous singers and contemporary chart-toppers performing country, bluegrass, Americana, folk, and gospel music as well as comedic performances and skits. It attracts hundreds of thousands of visitors from around the world and millions of radio and internet listeners.

The cost: \$80.00 per person, which includes transportation and Opry ticket.



WEDNESDAY – August 7th

The General Jackson Showboat (Evening show TBD)

One of the largest showboats ever built, the grand General Jackson is an elegant triumph of American ingenuity. With its elegant lacy filigree and stately design, the boat is reminiscent of the opulence of the American Victorian era. While “rollin’ down the river,” you’ll enjoy stunning views, a delicious meal freshly prepared, a full-service bar, and toe-tapping entertainment in our two-story Victorian Theater in the center of the boat. Your cruise lets you experience Nashville as it can best be seen from the beautiful Cumberland River.

Cost: \$140.00 per person, which includes transportation, cruise, dinner and show, taxes and gratuities. Minimum of 30 people to schedule this trip.



FRIDAY – *August 9th*

Day Trip: Jack Daniels Distillery followed by lunch at Miss Mary Bobo's (9:00am - 4:00pm)

Our day trip will be a tour of the Jack Daniels Distillery in Lynchburg, Tennessee. Upon arrival you will be put in groups of 20-25 for your tour to see where every drop of Jack Daniels Whiskey in the world is produced. TRIP NEWS & NOTES:

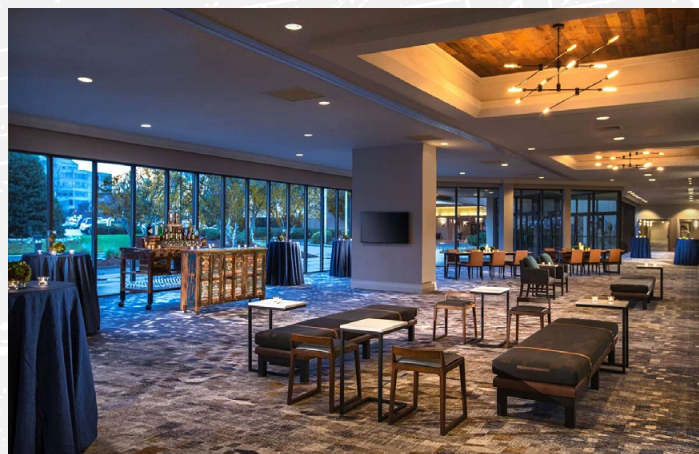
- A fuel surcharge may be added to each trip if required by the transportation company.
