## West Point/Woodbury Common Outlets – Monday, July 25<sup>th</sup>

Bus will depart Woodbury Common Outlets at 4:00pm

- Masks are required for part of the West Point tour, so please bring one.
- West Point is CASHLESS. You can ONLY use your debit/credit cards. Woodbury Commons accepts all forms of payments. Please see QR code below for coupon book of savings!
- If you get cold easily, bring a light jacket/sweatshirt to wear on the bus since the majority of the tour will be guided from your seat. We recommend you also bring a hat, sunscreen and wear good walking shoes.
- You can bring anything you would like to carry including backpacks, but they must stay on the bus at West Point. You can bring whatever you want to carry into the Woodbury Common Outlets.
- Food is on your own. When you get to the Woodbury Common Outlets, they have a food court.
- VERY IMPORTANT – for the West Point tour, you MUST bring the form of ID you provided to Elyse for the manifest, so please sure you have it on you when you get on the bus.

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## Cooperstown Baseball Hall of Fame – Tuesday, July 26<sup>th</sup>

Bus will depart Cooperstown at 2:15pm

- Masks are not required.
- All forms of payment are accepted.
- If you get cold easily, bring a light jacket/sweatshirt to wear on the air-conditioned bus to and from the venue. We recommend you also bring a hat, sunscreen and wear good walking shoes.
- You can bring anything you want to carry including backpacks, but they will be subject to inspection.
- You are encouraged to bring your personal flash & video cameras (not use your cell phone) since the lighting can be dim in many spots of the museum. They welcome your posting texts and videos with a tag @baseballhall on Twitter and Instagram, so they can see it and even share it!
- The Baseball Hall of Fame does have a limited number of courtesy wheelchairs available on a first-come first-served basis and they offer free Wi-Fi service during your visit.
- The Baseball Hall of Fame does not permit food and drink inside the museum; however, they do have drinking fountains on each floor.

- The boat has a small restroom located down a steep ladder into the crew quarters below deck. Anyone with limited mobility will have difficulty negotiating the ladder, so please be mindful of this before you board the boat. There is a portable restroom on the shore prior to departure.
- We will provide you with an assortment of non-alcoholic beverages and a boxed lunch/dinner, however, the boat does sell snacks and alcoholic beverages for sale. Please bring your 21+ ID to purchase alcohol.

## **911 Memorial & Museum – Thursday, July 28<sup>th</sup>**

Bus will depart 911 at 2:00pm

- Masks are not required but encouraged in the museum.
- All forms of payment are accepted at the museum.
- Please bring a hat and sunscreen if the day is warm and a light jacket/sweatshirt for a cooler day or to wear on the bus. We highly recommend comfortable walking shoes since there is a LOT to see in and around the 911 site.
- No bags larger than 19 x 17 x 8 inches will be allowed into the museum. All bags are subject to TSA screening.
- Continuing this tradition, the 911 Memorial & Museum welcomes visitors to place items of tribute (no larger than the bag size above) on the ground in front of the Memorial pools, on the bronze parapets surrounding the pools and on the stone monoliths of the Memorial Glade.
- You are encouraged to bring your personal flash & video cameras (not use your cell phone) since the lighting can be dim in many spots of the museum.
- We will provide you with a sealed bottle of water to take into the museum, however, food items are prohibited.
- The museum has courtesy wheelchairs that can be borrowed.

## **Yankee Game – Thursday, July 28<sup>th</sup>**

Bus will depart Yankee Stadium after the game – your bus leaders will tell you where.

- Masks are not required.
- Yankee Stadium is CASHLESS. You can ONLY use your debit/credit cards.
- Please bring a light jacket/sweatshirt for a cooler evening. We highly recommend comfortable walking shoes since there is a LOT to see inside the stadium, including Monument Park and the Yankee Museum.
- You are allowed to bring one bag into Yankee Stadium provided the bag is soft-sided and its dimensions do not exceed 16 x 16 x 8 inches. Briefcases, coolers, hard-sided bags or containers and air horns ARE NOT PERMITTED. All bags are subject to inspection and X-Ray screening.
- Guests are permitted to bring food into Yankee Stadium for individual consumption. We will provide you with a sealed bottle of water to take into the game.

## **Hudson River Cruise – Thursday, July 28<sup>th</sup>**

Bus will depart the hotel at 6:30pm

- Masks are not required.
- All forms of payment are accepted on the boat; debit/credit cards (\$10 minimum).
- Please dress for the day's weather. The boat is open-deck and canopy-covered, but there is no interior seating. The boat company recommends that you bring a hat and sunscreen if the day is warm and a light jacket/sweatshirt and scarf for a cooler night. Shoes or sandals ARE required.
- The boat has a small restroom located down a steep ladder into the crew quarters below deck. Anyone with limited mobility will have difficulty negotiating the ladder, so please be mindful of this before you board the boat. There is a portable restroom on the shore prior to departure.

- Masks are required for some indoor animal exhibits, so we recommend you bring one.
- All forms of payment are accepted at the Zoo.
- The Zoo is completely **SMOKE FREE**.
- Please bring a hat and sunscreen if the day is warm and a light jacket/sweatshirt for a cooler day or to wear on the bus. Comfortable walking shoes are a **MUST** for this 265-acre adventure.
- You can carry a backpack or small bag into the Zoo, which is subject to inspection.
- Guests are permitted to bring food into the Zoo for individual consumption. We will provide you with a sealed bottle of water to take into the Zoo.
- The Zoo has ECVs (Electric Convenience Vehicles) and Wheelchairs for rent **ONLY** at the entrance of the Zoo where the bus will drop you off. If you want to rent one, you should do it immediately upon entrance. Wheelchair rental is **FREE** (with a \$20 refundable credit card deposit) and the EVC rental is \$45/day (with a \$100 refundable credit card deposit). If you rent an EVC, pay attention to where the charging stations are.

## **MSG/Radio City & the NHL Store – Friday, July 29<sup>th</sup>**

- MSG and Radio City Music Hall are **CASHLESS**. You can **ONLY** use your debit/credit cards. The NHL Store will accept all forms of payment.
- Please bring a hat and sunscreen if the day is warm and a light jacket/sweatshirt for a cooler day or to wear on the bus. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended for the tours.
- You can carry a backpack or small bag into MSG and Radio City Music Hall that is subject to inspection.
- Stop 1 will be the NHL Store, where we have arranged for entry 1-hour prior to the public, stop 2 will be the World's Most Famous Arena and stop 3 will be Radio City Music Hall.
